

Construction Update: Summer of 2010

Last updated: January 2010

Beginning in June 2010, construction will begin on the new Germantown Academy Middle and Upper School building, to be located in the same space as the current Middle and Upper School. This project will have an impact on some of our summer programs. We anticipate the following temporary changes for our summer programs during construction:

- Academics: Middle and Upper School academic classes will be held in Lower School classrooms, outfitted with appropriate furniture for the ages of the students. Lower School academics will occur in the Lower School as usual. In most cases, courses for young students will occur on separate floors of the building from courses for older students.
- Art Quest: All clay and sculpture classes will be held in a Lower School art room. Middle/High School Art Quest classes will be taught in art classrooms located in the Arts Center. Art Quest Junior (for children entering K-1) is not going to be held this summer.
- Science Camp: Science Camp will occur in designated Lower School classrooms.
- Sports Camps: Sports camps will view training videos in the Common Room instead of in the Braun Study Hall. The Common Room is air conditioned.

All other camps, including Belfry Theatre Camp, will be held in their usual locations and should not be directly impacted by the construction.

We are very excited about this project and look forward to using the new facilities during the summer of 2012. In May, registered campers will receive a "Startup Packet" including specific arrival and departure procedures.
